
How to Adjust Labor Units

Underneath a product's image and name, you will see two buttons displayed -- Add to List and Product Number. The Add to List button will add the product to your personal list, while the Product Number button shows the specific product number for that item and will take you to the product page.



Most of the information on this product page is set by your manufacturer, such as product size, specifications and labor units. You can adjust labor units from their default value, in case an add-on or accessory requires more or less labor to install onto a vehicle in addition to the labor rates listed.
